<b>Name of unit</b>	<b>Leadership</b>
<b>Why do we study this unit?</b>	Leadership helps pupils to gain the skills and qualities needed to become positive influences around school peers. It is excellent for developing fundamental skills in communication, confidence, integrity and positivity. Leadership will stimulate social skills used in everyday life.
<b>By the end of the unit, students will be able to....</b>	Students will develop a basic understanding of the skills used in leadership. They will learn skills, rules and tactics surrounding these sports.
